Dear Families,

Please help us get ready for the 2015-2016 school year! In order for us to better provide our students with reliable transportation, it is important that you submit the most current information regarding your transportation needs for the 2015-2016 school year. **Please complete the transportation form on the back of this sheet and return it to your student's teacher by May 28.**

Please note the following important dates and information:

- **School begins August 24, 2015**, for students in grades 1-12 and **August 26, 2015**, for students in High Five and kindergarten.
- All High Five, kindergarten and 1st-7th grade students must complete a transportation form.
- Watch for a yellow postcard with your child's bus stop information to arrive in the mail in mid-August.
- Students will receive transportation if they live outside the walk zone and inside the attendance area for their school. Students can also receive transportation for a daycare address located outside the walk zone and inside the attendance area.
- **If you plan to move over the summer, please add your new address on the reverse side of this form.** If your new address may be outside the attendance area for your school, please contact Student Placement Services at 612-668-1840. Hmong-speaking families may call 612-668-1836. Somali- and Spanish-speaking families may call 612-668-3700.
- **If your pick-up or drop-off address changes or if you would like to confirm the information you provided**, please call the **Transportation Department at 612-668-2300** by August 1 to verify that the change is in place for the 2015-2016 school year.

Thank you for your cooperation. The information gathered with this form will allow the Transportation Department to develop safe and timely bus routes for MPS students.
