

# NEW CITY SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST 2018-19



New City School's learning environment promotes cooperation and community building and we therefore encourage shared-use of many classroom materials (especially in elementary classrooms). Please purchase the following items for your child(ren) as requested by their teacher(s) below. Please do not label the sharable materials with your child's name (pencils, crayons, glue, etc.).

Most K-5 classrooms also ask for a \$40 contribution per student to cover the cost of additional supplies and snacks, which are a part of our daily rhythm for elementary students. Some K-5 classrooms (noted below) only ask for \$20 as they have a different process whereby families bring in snack on a rotating basis throughout the year. Middle School students only need to bring \$20 as they do not receive daily snack.

\*If you are a parent of multiple students remember each student has their own class supply list and we ask that you provide items and contributions for each child as you are able. As always, if you would like to contribute more money to support other children you are welcome to do so.
